## Seaweeders

### *SeaWeeders Garden Club • Saturday February 2*

Join the SeaWeeders Saturday, February 2, starting at 9 a.m. for the first of our First Saturday sessions tending garden at the Solana Beach Post Office.

Throughout 2019, we will devote the first Saturday morning of each month to ongoing maintenance of the sculpture garden and grounds around the Post Office building at 153 S. Sierra Ave. Volunteers are welcomed — no gardening experience necessary. Just don a hat and some gloves and join your neighbors in keeping Solana Beach beautiful. (*Should it rain on the first Saturday, we will meet on the second Saturday. If it rains on both, we'll celebrate the rain.*)

The SeaWeeders Garden Club of Solana Beach (part of the city's Civic and Historical Society) completed a major overhaul of the Post Office landscape in 2014, installing new paths, benches, sculptures and bike racks. Last spring, the SeaWeeders removed and trimmed overgrown plants, added water-wise succulents, and laid three yards of mulch to help nurture the soil and keep down the weeds. Volunteers gather regularly for ongoing maintenance.

### *Cupid Loves Citrus*

That's a myth. But it's a fact that February is a good month to fertilize orange, tangerine and other citrus trees. So let Valentine's Day remind you to love your citrus.

Use an organic fertilizer made for citrus, and add worm castings to help the trees resist aphids and other insect pests. Work in gently, as citrus roots are shallow, and remember that those roots spread below ground as wide as the branches do above. Protect them with a healthy blanket of mulch. Repeat three to four times a year.
