Big Day for Bulky Waste and Pesticides!

Our SeaWeeders helped Solana Beach residents offload more than 700 pounds of unwanted pesticides and herbicides at the first Solana Beach Bulky Waste Cleanup Day to include this category of household hazardous waste. The garden club teamed with the City, its waste management vendors, and Solana Center for Environmental Innovation to sponsor the Oct. 6 event. It was so well received that discussion has begun about continuing, and perhaps even expanding options for hazardous waste drop-offs in future years.

Here are overall “stats”:

- 42 participants disposed of 717 pounds of herbicides and pesticides
- 200 households reserved curbside bulky-item pick-up, but EDCO ended up servicing about 500 homes
- 460 vehicles visited the collection site at La Colonia Community Center.
 - 192 brought bulky items
 - 159 brought electronic waste
 - 130 brought materials for shredding
- 3.47 tons of metal were collected and recycled
- 3.71 tons of e-waste were collected and recycled
- 2.64 tons of material were shredded and recycled
