# Election 2024 -- Learn the Pros & Cons of State Propositions

In addition to voting for President, a U.S. Senator, Congressional Representatives and California State Legislators, California voters this fall will also decide on 10 state propositions. Half were placed on the ballot of the State Legislature; the other five made the ballot through successful signature drives.

During our Thursday, October 10 member meeting at La Colonia Community Center, representatives from the League of Women Voters, San Diego chapter, will discuss the pros and cons of these propositions. The League of Women Voters is a non-profit, nonpartisan organization dedicated to encouraging informed and active participation in government. The League does not support or oppose candidates or political parties.

The ten statewide propositions follow:

### **Legislative Statutes**

- Proposition 2: Authorizes \$10 billion in bonds for public school and community college facilities.
- Proposition 3: Amends the California Constitution to define marriage as a fundamental right for all and remove language that states that marriage is only between a man and a woman.
- Proposition 4: Authorizes \$10 billion in bonds for safe drinking water, wildfire prevention and protecting commutates and natural lands from climate risks.
- Proposition 5: Allows local bonds for affordale housing and public infrastructure, with 55% voter approval.
- Proposition 6: Eliminates a constitutional provision allowing involuntary servitude for incarcerated pesons.

#### **Initiative Statutes**

- Proposition 32: Raises the minimum wage in California to \$18 an hour by January 1, 2026 and then each year based on inflation.
- Proposition 33: Expands local governments' authority to enact rent control on residential property.
- Proposition 34: Restricts spending of prescription drug revenues by certain health care providers and authorizes the state to negotiate Medi-Cal prices.
- Proposition 35: Provides permanent funding for Medi-Cal health care services by extending an existing tax on managed health care plans.
- Proposition 36: Allows felony charges and increases sentences for possessing certain drugs and for thefts under \$950, if the defendant has two prior drug or theft convictions.
